Edinburgh Guarantee Update

We are just over half way through our year; the employer engagement activity is going well with 213 opportunities identified and 144 young people matched into opportunities. Capital Document Solutions have recently recruited 3 young people to Trainee Stores roles and are currently advertising for another 3 young people for Workshop Trainee roles. Brand Agility, Bruntsfield Links Golf Course and Cornhill Building Services are just a few of the businesses who are offering young people opportunities with the support of our Wage Incentive for SMEs. Standard Life continue to champion our vision and recently started 17 young people on their 6 month Internship programme, with a vast majority

Modern Apprenticeships: Young Scot and Creative Digital Media Apprenticeship

Young Scot has supported The Edinburgh Guarantee since its inception, and currently supports young people into Digital and Creative Media roles through their Apprenticeship programmes. An example of this is the Digital Creative Pathways Apprenticeship. It offers young people the opportunity to develop professional creative and digital media skills, and essential employability and soft skills to give them a strong start in their working life making them an asset to future employers. The Apprenticeship lasts for a minimum of 12 months, during which time Young Scot supports the apprentices to achieve the BTEC Edexcel Digital and Creative Media at Level 3. Springboard's KickStart programme in Edinburgh

Following last year's success, Springboard's KickStart programme will start in November and is supported by the Edinburgh Guarantee. The programme provides school leavers with a transitional programme focused toward entering employment and apprenticeships within the Hospitality industry. The programme works in partnership with businesses in Edinburgh, including BaxterStorey, Compass ESS, Premier Inn, Delaware North and The G1 Group. The participants will take part in a three week structured training programme which includes a training week providing certified short courses, expert career advice and



Youth Employability Day

Skills Development Scotland in partnership with Western Edinburgh Neighbourhood Partnership hosted a 'Youth Employability Day' at Drumbrae Library Hub on 29th October. The event was targeted at young people aged 16 -19, particularly those who have already disengaged with school or will be leaving school at Christmas. The event provided an opportunity for young people to get advice on job vacancies, college courses, volunteering opportunities and to take part in workshops. A wide variety of providers was represented ranging from Edinburgh College to Jobcentre Plus, and around 60 young people attended the event.



Skills Scotland Edinburgh

Prospects hosted the annual Skills Scotland event at Royal Highland Showground on the 31st of October. The event was attended by 2,500 current school pupils and recent leavers from Edinburgh and the surrounding areas where they were offered the chance to explore their career options. There was a huge variety of employers and training providers present, including Apprenticeships in Scotland, Skills Development Scotland, The Royal Bank of Scotland and many more. Young people got the chance to get involved in practical activities such as milking cows, icing cupcakes and hair and nail demonstrations. The Edinburgh Guarantee stall engaged with over 200 young people, highlighting the variety of jobs available within Edinburgh as well as the School Leavers Toolkit. Feedback was gathered on the stall which will be

collated and used to develop our resources in the future.
